The Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer (LGBTQ) & Sexuality Studies Minor is available to students enrolled in Bachelor's degree programs at MSU. This minor provides the opportunity to obtain a comprehensive, global, cross/interdisciplinary academic experience in sexualities, gender identity and expression, and queer identities and activism. The minor complements a wide range of majors and is especially suited for students who plan to work with or advocate for issues of diversity, inclusion, and cross-cultural understandings.

With the approval of the department/college that administers the student's degree program, courses that are used to meet the requirements for the minor might also be used to satisfy the requirements for their degree.
